Constituent Service and Accountability

- ✓ Working with my office staff on constituent issues and concerns
- ✓ Hosting regular district office hours (virtually during the pandemic)

Legislative Work

- ✓ Filed two dozen pieces of legislation on a variety of public policy issues
- ✓ Released a comprehensive Legislative Agenda for the 2021-2022 session
- ✓ Appointed to serve on several important legislative committees (see below)

Supporting and Honoring Veterans and Seniors

- ✓ Appointed to serve as the Ranking Minority Member on the Joint Committee on Veterans and Federal Affairs and a Member of the Joint Committee on Elder Affairs
- ✓ Actively supported changes proposed for the Soldiers Home in Holyoke
- ✓ Ongoing support for the Food4Vets and Coats4Vets charitable programs

Working to Improve Our Communities

- ✓ Collaboration with town administrators, select boards, and school committees
- ✓ Support for enhanced Local Aid, education (c. 70) funds, and roadway (c. 90) funding
- ✓ Working with local officials on coastal erosion and wastewater management

Protecting Public Safety and Supporting First Responders

- ✓ Appointed to serve on the Joint Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security
- ✓ Ongoing advocacy to fight the opioid epidemic, including proposals to increase penalties for those who deal fentanyl
- ✓ Filed legislation to allow mental health advocates to accompany first responders
- ✓ Filed legislation to permit emergency medical treatment of injured police dogs (Nero’s Bill) and charitable fundraising for injured first responders (Lennon’s Law)

Supporting Small Businesses

- ✓ Supported freezing Unemployment Insurance rates for MA employers
- ✓ Filed legislation to protect small businesses from taxes on pandemic relief funds
- ✓ Ongoing support for reopening businesses across Cape Cod as soon as possible
